We are dedicated to providing a safe environment for all.

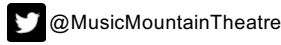
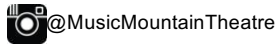
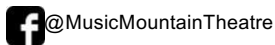
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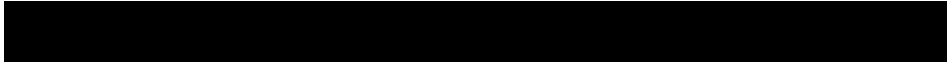

IN-PERSON AND VIRTUAL CLASSES

classes run Mondays – Thursdays
 beginning JAN. 18 and commencing on APR. 8

THEATRE DANCE /JAZZ -Beginner **Thursday 4:00 – 5:00** **\$300**
This beginner level class will focus on basic theatre dance and traditional jazz techniques. In this course, students will gain knowledge of theatre dance terminology and experience dancing several styles of theatre choreography.

THEATRE DANCE /JAZZ–Intermediate **Thursday 5:00 – 6:00** **\$300**
This intermediate level class will focus on developing theatre dance and traditional jazz techniques. Dancers will focus on strength, flexibility, balance, and musicality - incorporating turns and leaps.

THEATRE DANCE /JAZZ–Advanced **Wednesday 6:00 – 7:00** **\$300**
This advanced level class will focus on applying theatre dance techniques while continuing to explore various dance styles used in theater. Emphasis will also be placed on learning performance skills such as connecting with the audience and telling a story through dance and facial expressions.

BROADWAY CARDIO–All Levels *virtual* **Thursday 7:00 – 8:00** **\$300**
This class combines dance and fitness set to some of musical theatre's high energy songs. This class is fun and places emphasis on rhythm and musicality. Students are provided an engaging technique class and fun choreography.

BALLET In Person-Intermediate **Wednesday 5:00 – 6:00** **\$300**
This intermediate level class will focus on developing ballet techniques; advancing work on jumps and turns and traveling across the floor. Students will also continue to expand their vocabulary of classical French terminology and learn to apply it to musical theatre ballet.

TAP I– Beginner *virtual* **Tuesday 4:00 – 5:00** **\$300**
This beginner level class will focus on basic tap techniques. Students will work on developing new motor skills, enhancing coordination, gaining better balance, and strengthening leg and ankle muscles.

TAP II – In Person - Intermediate **Tuesday 5:00 – 6:00** **\$300**
This intermediate level class will focus on developing tap techniques. Building on principles learned in Tap I, this class continues the development of technique with a focus on speed, transitions, and style.

TAP III – In Person - Advanced **Tuesday 6:00 – 7:00** **\$300**
This advanced level class is specifically designed for tap dancers at the professional level. This course follows the structure of a traditional tap class, placing emphasis on technique and musicality.

TRIPLE THREATS, JR (ages 5 – 7) *virtual* **Monday 4:00 – 5:00** **\$300**
This preparatory class will explore the joy that is unique to musical theatre. Natural born entertainers will use their voice in theatrical ways, execute multiple kinds of movement, and convey emotions through imaginative play, games, and challenges. Newly acquired skills will be featured in a showcase.

TRIPLE THREATS I (ages 8 – 10) **Monday 5:00 – 6:00** **\$300**
Students in this course will refine the skills necessary to perform as a company. With a focus on teamwork, active listening, and synchronization, triple threats will develop the skills necessary to speak in unison, sing as a chorus, and dance as an

ensemble. This course will culminate in a final presentation to showcase newly acquired skills

TRIPLE THREATS II (ages 11 – 13) **Monday 6:00 – 7:00** **\$300**
Performers will learn and apply practical techniques to successfully audition, rehearse, and collaborate in a live arts production. This course ranges from preparing a 16- bar song cut, to composing a resumé, to building vocal stamina while dancing, to dressing room etiquette. This course will culminate in a final presentation to showcase newly acquired skills.

TRIPLE THREATS III (ages 14 – 18) **Tuesday 7:00 – 8:00** **\$300**
Students in this course will focus on their individual contributions to the performing arts and their ability to develop technology techniques for creating self-tapes. Each triple threat will analyze song as text, breakdown comedic/dramatic monologues, and learn and execute choreography from Broadway shows. *For additional fees, students may compete in a regional competition in February.

ZOOMSICAL (ages 8 – 10) *virtual* **Wednesday 5:00 – 6:00** **\$300**
Learn how to work your Zoom space and perform an adaptation of a children's musical. Explore scene work, memorization techniques, choreography, and acting a song. The production will be filmed for family and friends to enjoy.

ZOOMSICAL (ages 11 – 16) *virtual* **Thursday 5:00 – 6:30** **\$350**
Perform a Louis Palena original children's theatre musical. MMT staff will work on the scenes, choreography, and vocals during the session. The production will be filmed and edited for family & friends to enjoy. *Additional rehearsals and filming times will be coordinated with performers.

SPECIAL NEEDS ACTING (ages 14 -Above) *virtual* **Wednesday 4:00 – 5:00** **\$300**
Join our warm, inclusive group of uniquely abled performers with special needs and let your creativity run wild. In addition to theatre exercises and games, performers in this class joyfully write and perform in skits, commercials, and imaginative scenes. Performers will work toward creating a cumulative performance.

COSTUMING 101 - All Ages **Wednesday 4:00 – 5:00** **\$300**
Join our amazing costume designer in an intro to costuming skills, including machine use & maintenance, as well as hand sewing techniques

COMEDY IMPROV (ages 10 – 16) *virtual* **Wednesday 6:00 – 7:00** **\$300**
This class incorporates scene work and group exercises to explore the primary fundamentals of improvisation, making performers more confident, comfortable, and trusting on stage. Learn how to think positively, accept all possibilities, initiate and commit to any circumstance, and deliver fun, quality performances. This course will culminate in a final improvised presentation to showcase newly acquired skills.

ACTING & CREATING - ONE-ACT (10-16) *virtual* **Wednesday 7:00 – 8:00** **\$300**
Develop techniques to be an effective actor and scene partner. Explore one-act plays and scenes requiring in-depth character study. Collaborate to create an original one-act. Walk away with a movie showcasing your talents. This class is ideal for building confidence, sharing creative ideas, and exploring the written word.
